- 3.1. <u>Camille McKay, Manager, Parking Enforcement, in regards to parking enforcement procedures</u>

Camille McKay, Manager, Parking Enforcement, provided a PowerPoint presentation discussing the mandate of parking enforcement staff, school enforcement practices, awareness and parking ticket statistics in school zones.

Committee Members raised concerns about persistent illegal parking in school zones and inquired about the feasibility of increased ticketing, increased ticketing fees and towing in order to deter this behaviour. Ms. McKay responded that ticketing does not always equal a behavioural change in illegal parking offenders. Ms. McKay noted that parking enforcement staff had been part of a 2 year study to evaluate the needs of parking enforcement for the proposed Parking Master Plan. Ms. McKay also noted that upgrading parking enforcements systems and technology would assist staff in increasing their service level.

5.6. Site Inspection Report – Lisgar Middle School (Ward 10)

Site Inspection Report for the safety review conducted on April 26, 2019 at 6755 Lisgar Drive for the students attending Lisgar Middle School.

Councillor McFadden raised concerns regarding the receipt of the site inspection report. Councillor McFadden advised the committee that during her visits to the school she had observed unsafe vehicular behaviour when exiting the kiss and ride and requested that another site inspection take place before the end of the school year.
